Be an Official in just 3 EASY Steps

1. REGISTER:

Visit us at: ihsaa.org, under the Officials tab

- Scroll to the bottom of the page to obtain directions regarding registration as a new official.
- The 2019-20 Official Registration Link will lead you to the IHSAA Membership Portal where you will register for your license
- Complete Registration and the IHSAA will have Rule Books in the mail to your listed address

2. IHSAA BACKGROUND CHECK

- Conducted prior to consideration for licensure

3. EXAM

- Study the rules book before you take the test.
- Go to myihsaa.net enter your user name (email address) and password.

3. EXAM Cont.

- Click on the Officials tab located in the top menu bar.
- From the dropdown, select EXAM.
- You will see all exams for which you registered.
- Select START to begin your Open Book, Untimed exam.
- You may close and resume later as needed
- You may use the rules book sent to you to take the test.
- Take your time when submitting your test answers.
- Once the test is submitted, you are finished.
- You will receive immediate feedback on the result. (75% or better is required. Two trials are permitted for each sport exam.)
- Upon successful completion of the exam, you will receive your insignia and license card from IHSAA.
