Penn plays Sanga Margarita, the East Lake Eagles and the Notre Dame Saints in pool play.


The Kingsmen are 26-13-1 and won the City Championship this season.


Assistant Coach Jim Hiss







LIGHTING THE LAMP IN THE COMMUNITY



Every year, the Penn Hockey team does at least one community service event per month. Here is a list by month of the Kingsmen giving back to the community:

- March Our most recent event was the Spaghetti Dinner Fundraiser where we served more than 300 dinners to families, including 25 dinners to a homeless shelter, 19 children in 11 homes through CPS (Child Protective Services) and 55 meals to the St Joseph County Police.
- March We worked with the Clay Church Food Pantry, helping to remove carpet, and relocate their food pantry which included dozens of loaded up pallets containing canned food, bread and non-perishable foods.
- February All 4 Animals Rescue thoroughly appreciated our help working in their animal shelter. We walked dogs, socialized the cats and dogs, and helped them clean out and reorganize their kennel area.
- January Packing up meals for Cultivate Culinary was a fun way to give back to the community. We helped pack over 800 meals for people in need. This is an amazing organization that takes food from events, stores, or restaurants that is unused and packages them into meals to hand out to people who need them. They are saving unused food from being wasted and giving out to people in need.
- December The entire Penn Hockey team took turns ringing bells for the Salvation Army outside Walmart, and Sam's Club in Mishawaka. This was another way for the team to help out the community face to face by raising money for a great cause.
- November Every Thanksgiving the Penn Hockey team donates the Ronald McDonald's House Thanksgiving dinner. The people that stay in the home have a child receiving medical treatment and are unable to be home during Thanksgiving holiday. These people come from all over so it is nice to help out people in difficult situations. Each member of the team brings a specific dish and all together we make one big meal.
- October We did two different community service events in October. The first one was
 with Elkhart Ministries. We helped tear down abandoned houses so they can be
 remodeled into new houses for women who need a new start in life. We also helped the
 525 Foundation and St Joseph County during their Say Boo to Drugs Halloween Trick or
 Treat outreach. We passed out and drug prevention materials to children
- September Our first event of the year was for the 525 Foundation. We ran in their 5.25k Run for drug prevention. The whole team ran around the 5k run around the Mishawaka river walk.
