The Fighting Irish banged out 14 hits. ... Cathedral averages 9.7 runs a game during its seven-game winning streak.

Coach Dikos owns a 796-276 record (.743) in 34 seasons.

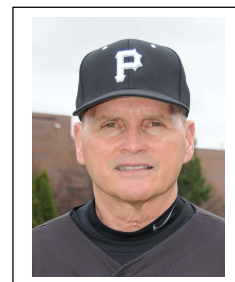
Penn has won four State Championships during Dikos' tenure as head coach – 1994, 1998, 2001, and 2015.

Coach Dikos has also led Penn to six Semi-State Championships, 12 Regional Championships, 20 Sectional Championships and 20 Northern Indiana Conference Championships.

A graduate of Swartz Creek High School (Mich.) and Ball State University, Coach Dikos was selected by the Atlanta Braves as a third baseman in the 1979 Major League Baseball Draft in the 31st round.

Coach Dikos was inducted into the Indiana Baseball Hall of Fame in 2011.

Coach Dikos played on the 1974 Connie Mack National Championship team, and is in the Flint (Mich.) Area Hall of Fame.

Quick hits

Championship Legacy

On Father's Day weekend, Penn Junior starting 2B **Colton Hudnall** will compete for a State Championship. His father, Chad Hudnall, was a starting player on the South Bend Clay Boys Basketball Team that won the IHSAA State Championship in 1994. Chad Hudnall passed away in 2013 after a courageous battle against cancer. Survivors included Chad's wife, Catherine, and four children who at the time were ages 9-through-5. Chad Hudnall was the Clay Baseball Varsity Head Coach, and he was an assistant coach for Boys Basketball. Clay retired his No. 14 in 2014.

Baseball magnet

Penn Senior Starting CF **Zach Hoskins** has been hit by a pitch 20 times this season, matching his program record from the 2021 season. Hoskins returned to the Kingsmen line-up after off-season knee surgery. He is hitting .412 and has driven in 14 runs. Hoskins is a Lake Erie College commit.

Strong return

Penn Senior Starting P **Ben Gregory** returned to the Kingsmen after off-season elbow surgery. Gregory was the Northern Indiana Conference MVP last season with a 0.00 ERA in 31.1 IP (5-0 NIC record). Overall, Gregory was 7-0 with a 1.11 ERA. This season, Gregory is 3-1, 2.07 ERA, 37 K, 8 BB. Gregory has been a powerful force at the plate for the Kingsmen. He is hitting .373 with 30 RBIs. Gregory has hit six doubles and three triples. Gregory is a Maryville College commit.

Breakthrough season

Penn Junior P **Brayden Schoetzow** is 10-0 this season with a 1.37 ERA, 62 K, 14 BB. He closed Sectional Championship Game victory against Northridge and earned the win - 4.2 IP, 0 R, 5 H, 3K, 0BB. Schoetzow did not pitch in the Regional, but in the Semi-state earned the victory, entering the game in the sixth and getting a double play to help Penn escape a jam with the score tied 2-2. Schoetzow vs. Zionsville - 2 IP, 0 R, 0 H, 1 K, 0 BB. Last season, Schoetzow was 3-2 with a 4.20 ERA, 22 K and 14 BB.

Senior success

Three of Penn's seniors – Zac David, Zach Hoskins and Hunter Mrozinski – each played key roles in the Penn Football Team claiming the Sectional Championship. David played wide receiver for the Kingsmen, Hoskins played as a defensive back and Mrozinski handled linebacker duties.

Mental Attitude Award

Penn boasts three Baseball players who have won the IHSAA Mental Attitude Award. Blake Gaugler won the award in 1998, Tim Lira won the award in 2015, and Trevor Waite won the event in 2017.

One-run battles

The Kingsmen have suffered six losses, and three of those were by one run. The Kingsmen are 2-3 in one-run games.

Tourney tested

Penn has faced several tough battles in the IHSAA State Tournament. Penn and Zionsville were tied at 2-2 in the sixth inning of the Semi-state Championship Game. The Kingsmen scored two runs in the bottom of the sixth inning and went on to earn a 4-2 victory, clinching a spot in the State Championship Game. Penn trailed Lake Central 4-3 in the fourth inning of the Regional Championship Game, but tied the score in the bottom of the fourth inning and won the game on a walk-off single by Zac David with two out in the bottom of the seventh inning. The 5-4 victory earned Penn a berth in the Semi-state. Penn also had to rally to eliminate Northridge in the Sectional Championship. The Kingsmen trailed Northridge 5-4 after three innings, but two runs in the fourth and another in the sixth led the Kingsmen to a 7-5 victory. Penn also trailed in its Sectional Semi-Final Game against Warsaw. The Tigers took a 1-0 lead in the first inning, but Penn countered with two runs in the second inning and one run in the fourth inning on the way to a 3-1 victory.
