The IHSAA will announce date/time/location after the Sectional Championships. ... Northridge defeated Penn 51-49 on Tuesday, Dec. 19, at Penn. ... Penn has won 22 Sectional Championships, the last in 2022. ... Northridge ended a streak of five consecutive Sectional Championships by the Kingsmen last season. ... Northridge owns three Sectional Championships, the last in 2023. ... Penn Coach Kristi Ulrich and Northridge coach Doug Springer have both been on the Indiana Girls Basketball All-Star coaching staff in their illustrious careers. ... Ulrich was the Indiana All-Stars head coach last season, and Springer was an assistant in 2020.

#### Coach Kristi Kaniewski Ulrich

Kristi Kaniewski Ulrich graduated from Mishawaka High School and went on to play basketball at Bethel College.

Penn captured the 2016 Class 4-A state crown under Ulrich's guidance. Penn was state runner-up in 2011 and 2014.

Ulrich is 330-56 in her 15th season as the Kingsmen coach. She is Penn's all-time winningest Girls Basketball coach and was the 2023 Indiana All-Star Head Coach.

Penn has won one State Championship, three Semistate Championships, five Regional Championships, 11 Sectional Championships and 11 Northern Indiana Conference Championships with Ulrich as head coach.

## Kingsmen own proud Hoosier Hysteria history

Penn boasts a proud history in the Indiana High School Athletic Association Girls Basketball State Tournament. Kingsmen Head Coach Kristi Kaniewski Ulrich guided Penn to the 2016 Class 4-A State Championship. In addition to one State Championship, Penn boasts three Semi-State Championships, nine Regional Championships and 22 Sectional Championships.

Northern Regional hosts include LaPorte, Marion, Jimtown, Bellmont, Winamac, Lapel, Caston and Wes-Del.

There are two Regional Championship Games at each site. The IHSAA will announce where Regional Championship Games will be held after the Sectional Championship have been determined.

#### Ulrich named Indiana All-Star coach in 2023

Penn Girls Basketball Coach Kristi Ulrich was the Head Coach of the Indiana Girls Basketball All-Stars in their two-game series against Kentucky. She is the first Penn Basketball Head Coach to earn the prestigious honor as an All-Star Head Coach. Urlich led Penn to a State Championship in 2016.

## **Echols signs with Ancilla**

Karleisha Echols will take her Academic and Basketball talents to Ancilla College.

She credited Penn with preparing her for the collegiate level.

"I think that playing for Penn has taught me the value of hard work and dedication," Echols said. "Coach (Ulrich) has us playing against strong opponents which helps me adapt to different playing styles and strategies that will be useful next year. Our coaching staff has always pushed me to be my best, both on and off the court, and the lessons I've learned will help me go to the next level."
